Past Year Use



14% of grade 7 to 12 students used cigarettes

6% of grade 7 to 12 students used cigarettes for the first time

24% of grade 12 students used cigarettes (peak)

12% of grade 11 students used cigarettes for the first time (peak)

of grade 9 to 12 students tried smoking marijuana, hash oil or wax with e-cigarettes (among those who used e-cigarettes)



19% of grade 7 to 12 students used e-cigs

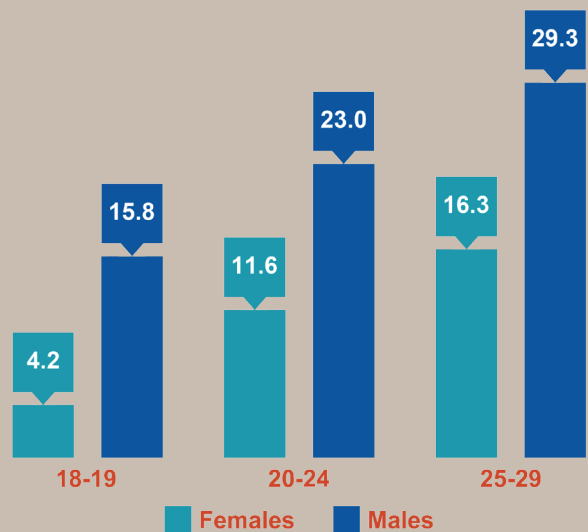
30% of grade 11 students used e-cigarettes (peak)
